Zvartnots airport, Yerevan transport, money, visa check & emergency

BEFORE YOU LEAVE RELIABLE WI-FI

- ☐ Save your first hotel address and phone number directly on your phone.
- ☐ Download an offline map of Yerevan and your next destination.
- ☐ Check your passport's Armenia entry/visa rule on the official MFA website.
- ☐ If you need an eVisa, use only the official portal: evisa.mfa.am.
- ☐ Keep some Armenian dram (AMD) for cash-only transport and small purchases.
- ☐ Save your flight, accommodation and insurance details offline.
- ☐ Save Armenia's unified emergency number: 112.

ZVARTNOTS AIRPORT -> YEREVAN QUICK CARD

Option	What to know
Bus N100	Airport <-> Yerevan city. 500 AMD. Every 30 min from 06:50 to 22:00; hourly overnight. Pay by Telcell QR/paper QR or Visa/Mastercard on board.
Bus N201 (Elitebus)	Airport <-> Yerevan city. 300 AMD. Every 30 min from 07:00 to 22:00. Cash payment in AMD.
Taxi	Use an airport-listed operator or a trusted booked service. Confirm your destination and displayed/quoted price before leaving.
Late arrival	N100 is the public-transport backup listed by the airport through the night; re-check the live airport transport page after landing.

Airport fares and schedules can change. The airport currently lists both N100 and N201, but always check the live Zvartnots transport page before relying on an old screenshot.

YEREVAN PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Need	Practical move
Single city ride	Yerevan introduced a 150 AMD single-ride tariff. Validate the ticket/payment for each bus, trolleybus or metro ride.
Pay without cash	The city moved away from cash fares. Current options include a reusable transport card, a mobile ticket/app and contactless bank-card payment.
Get a transport card	The city says cards are available at metro station terminals/ticket offices, Telcell service points and information centers.
Paper QR ticket	Single-use paper QR tickets were phased out from 1 August 2025. Do not build your plan around buying one.
Unsure what works	Check transport.yerevan.am or ask at a metro ticket office before loading a larger ticket package.

MONEY & PAYMENT BACKUP

- ☐ Currency: Armenian dram (AMD). Prices and domestic payments are quoted in dram.
- ☐ Carry a small cash reserve even if you normally use cards.
- ☐ Keep smaller notes for buses, cafés, markets and payment failures.
- ☐ At Zvartnots, N201 specifically requires cash in AMD; N100 accepts listed cashless options.
- ☐ Do not exchange a large amount before checking the displayed rate and fees.

ENTRY / VISA: DO NOT GUESS

Visa requirements depend on nationality and travel document. Check the Armenia Ministry of Foreign Affairs before travel. The MFA links to the official eVisa system at evisa.mfa.am; some nationalities are visa-exempt while others have different application rules.

Avoid look-alike visa websites. If you need an Armenian eVisa, start from the MFA or type evisa.mfa.am yourself.
